Enhanced Access Clinics - project 3

Funding will cease in october .New extended hours service to begin at Seacroft along current sessions at St Georges centre. Hopefully there will be some form of physio first service to continue as this has also been a great success for tps to access a physio in practices. NB AH brought up the parking issue at Seacroft that needs feeding back to the locality and the CCG, £2.10 to park and meters only take cards no cash. You have to walk through the hospital to purchase a scratch card to put on your car. Can GC feed back and we discussed that parking should be free evening and w'ends for primary care pts attending Extended access apts.

Parking is free at St George's centre.

Also transport issue for pts living in Rothwell/Oulton area costly and not much public transport links to get to seacroft.
