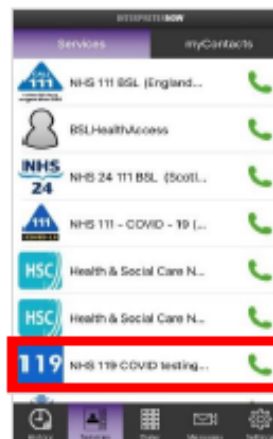


## How to download the British Sign Language (BSL) InterpreterNow App

A face-to-face British Sign Language (BSL) Interpreter is not available. You can access a BSL Interpreter using InterpreterNow. Using a PC or smartphone, you make a video call to connect with a BSL Interpreter to help with your COVID-19 vaccination. Please follow these instructions:

### 1) If you have a mobile phone with internet access:

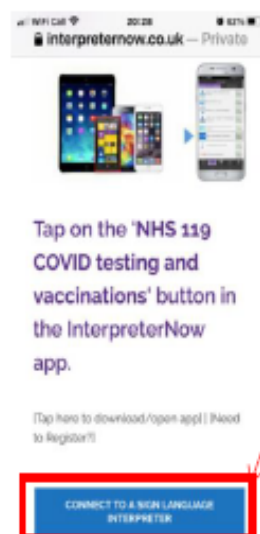
If you already have the InterpreterNow App on your phone, please access the 119 service using your login details. Please click the NHS 119 button, highlighted in the red box in the picture below, which will connect you with a BSL Interpreter.



If you do not have the InterpreterNow App, please follow the instructions:

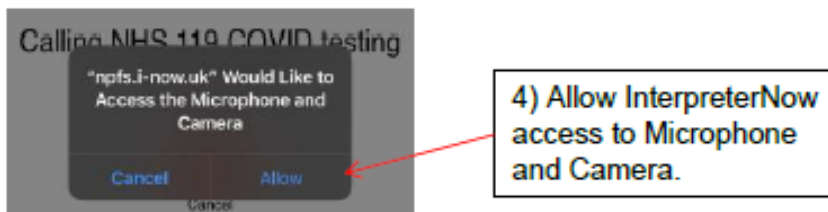


1) Using your smartphone, go to: <https://interpreternow.co.uk>, scroll down and tap 'NHS 119'
